

Magento 2 Customer Attributes and Customer Address Attributes Documentation

Introduction

- **Customer Attributes**

Customer attributes provide the information that is required to support the order, fulfillment, and customer management processes.

You can add custom attributes to customer account create which help us get more information about customer.

With its help you can add customer *Profile Picture* and you can make your website more attractive

- **Customer Address Attributes**

The Customer Address attribute set determines the properties of street addresses that are entered into the address book from the customer's account or during checkout.

Custom address attributes can be set up to provide additional information, such as an optional email address, Skype account, alternate phone number, building, or country.

Customer address attributes can also be used in the Billing Information section during checkout, or when guests register for an account.

Installation

1. Download '**Attribute**' Extension zip.
2. Extract Files.
3. In your magento2 project's directory follow this path src->app->code and make a new directory **Sprinix** .
4. Copy Extracted folder '**Attribute**' and paste it here.
5. Open window Terminal and change path to magento2 project's directory.
6. Run following commands:

bin/magento setup:upgrade;
bin/magento setup:di:compile;
bin/magento setup:static-
content:deploy -f;

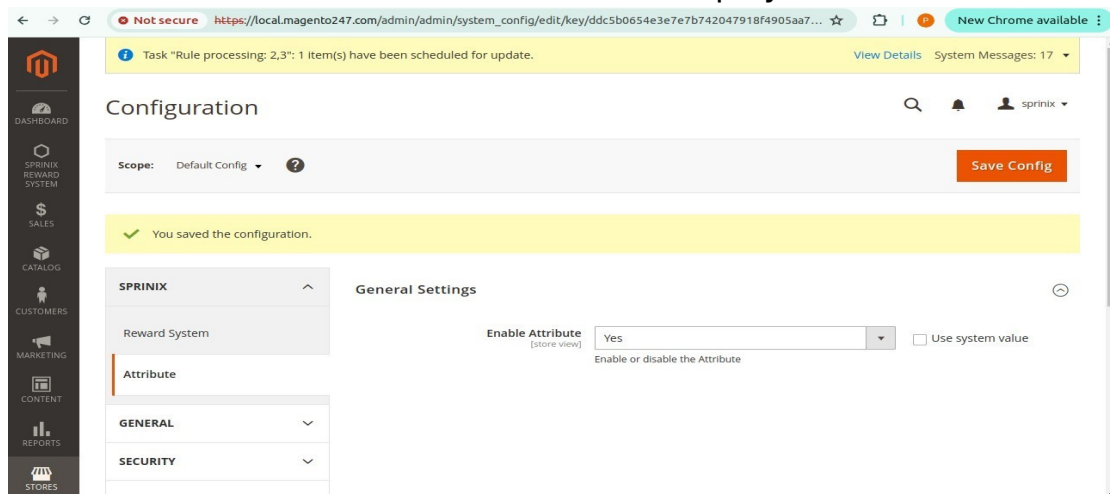
7. Now all the new settings of this extension can be seen in the project Admin.

Admin Store Configuration

To Configure the Sprinx Attribute Extension for your stores follow the path given below

STORES -> Configuration -> SPRINIX -> Attributes

For the field, 'Enable Module' , select 'Yes' to enable the extension, if field is set to 'No' then module will not display on menu.

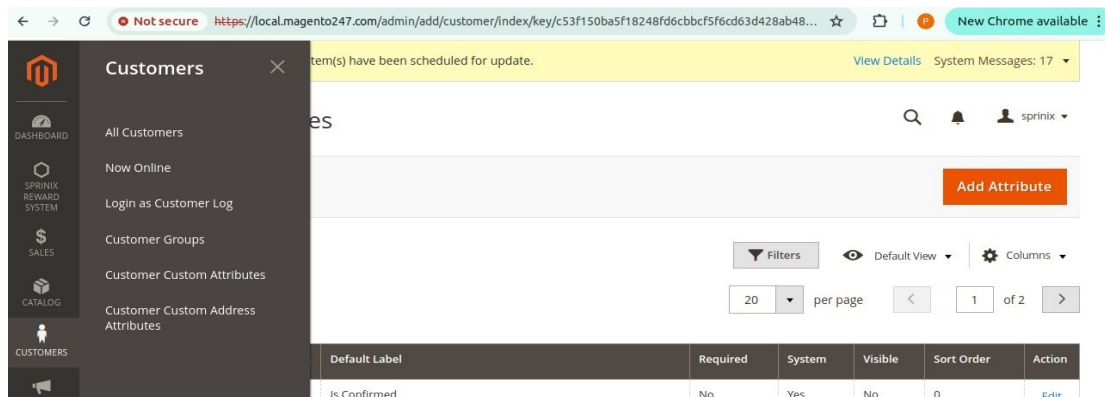


Admin Customer Attributes And Customer Address Attributes

Follow the path given below to manage “Customer Attributes”

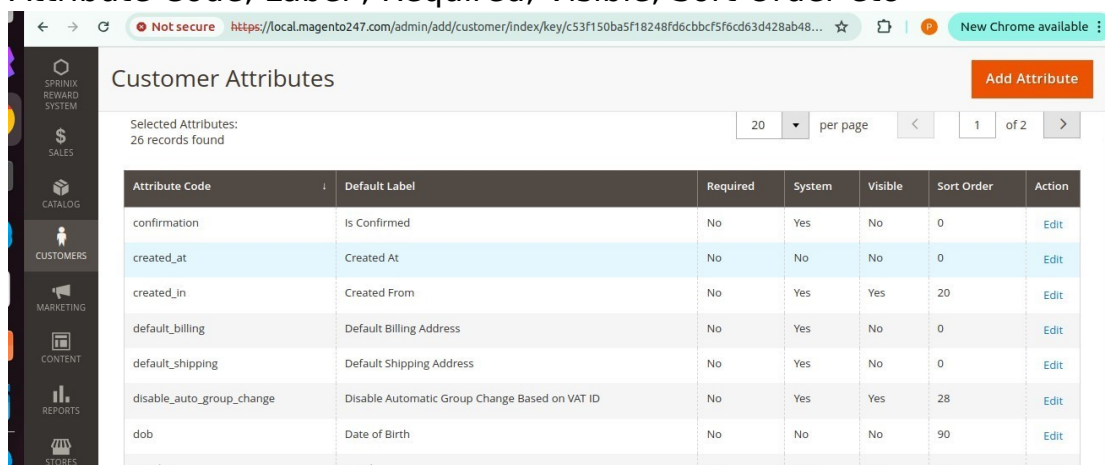
Customers-->Customer Custom Attributes

Attribute Code, Label, Required, Visible, Sort Order etc

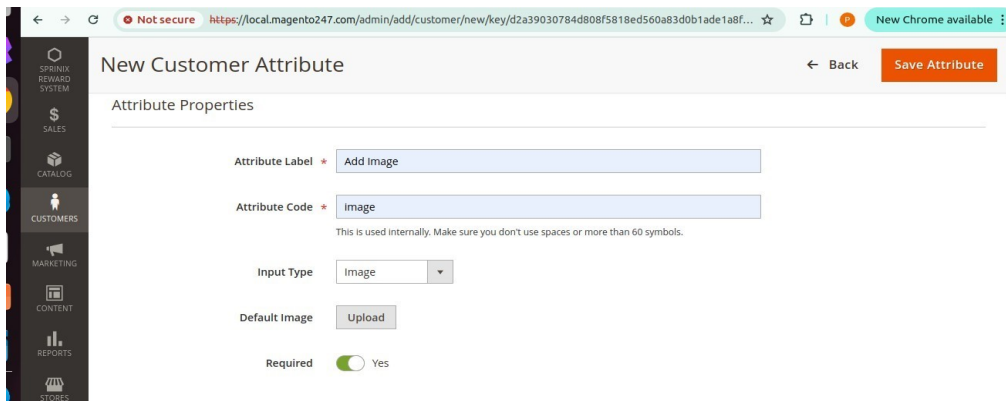


Add New Customer Attributes

Attributes Form 1. Attribute Properties

- For the field, 'Attribute Label', write a Caption for form.
- For the field, 'Attribute Code', write a unique code for form.
- For the field, 'Input Type', choose input type for that you have to add .
- " **Note** If you select 'Input Type →image' then you should write Attribute Code 'image' and also you have allow customer's media access. "
- After this the 'Default Value', of the input type will be shown.
- For the field, 'Required', click 'Yes', if you want to required field.



2. **Advanced Attribute Properties**

- For the field, 'Unique Value' click 'Yes', If you want unique value.
- Select, 'Input Validation', for which type of form you want to validate.
- For this field, 'Add To Column', click on 'Yes' If you want to show this field and field data in 'All Customer' grid.
- For this field, 'Use in Filter Option', click 'Yes' If you want to show it in the 'Filter' option of 'All Customer' grid.

3. **Visibility**

- For the field, 'Visible', click 'Yes' If you want to show .
- For the field, 'Sort Order', give numeric value which sort order you want to show.
- For the field, 'Form to use in', select the value on which layout you want to show the form.

2. **Manage Title**


- For the field, 'Default Store View', give 'Label' name which show on 'frontend'.

Display Form on Customer Account Create on Frontend



In this way you can save and show “Customer Custom Attributes” .

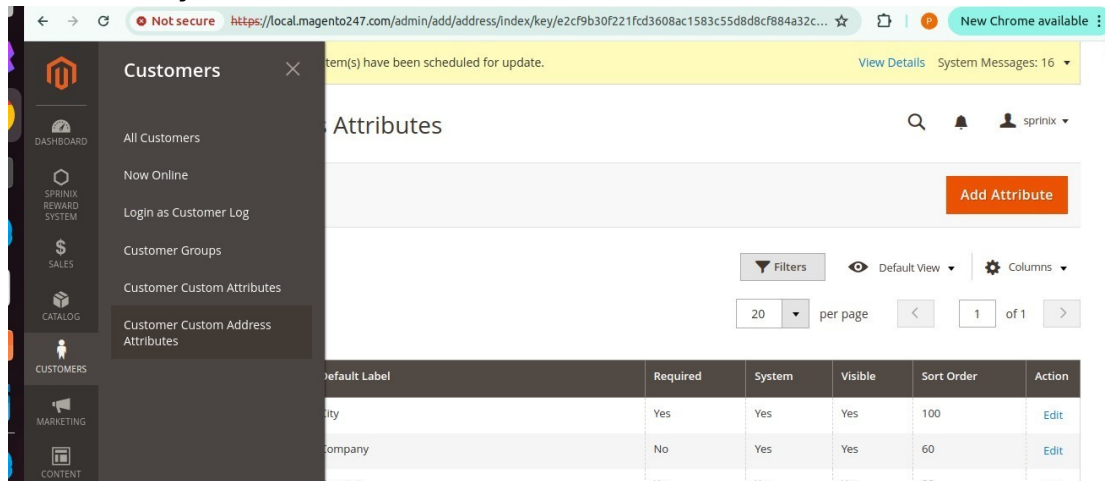
- So now you will see the steps to save and show “Customer Address Attributes”.

- Now ,Open “Customer Menu” again and click on “Customer Custom Address Attributes”.

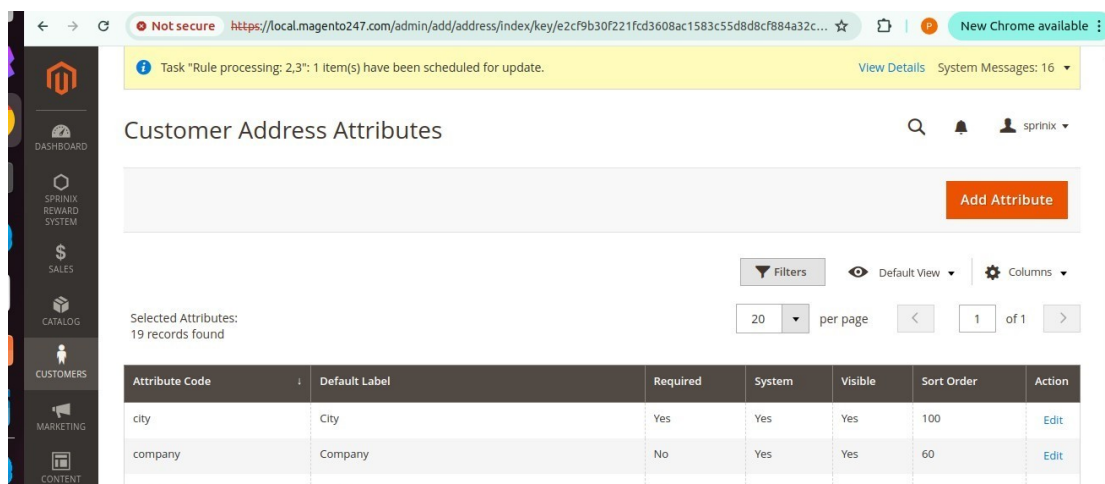
Follow this path for manage “Customer Address Attributes”


2. Manage Title

Display Form on Checkout on frontend




